

Football Manager

1. Purpose

The core purpose of the Football Manager is to manage a team to represent the Society in fixtures arranged.

2. Duties

The main duties of the Football Manager include:

- Arranging for players and officials to participate in the Ian “Winkle” Mitchell Memorial fixture;
- Arranging for a team to represent the Society at SCRA events;

This list is not exhaustive and the Football Manager may be required, from time to time, to undertake other ad hoc duties and responsibilities on behalf of the Society.

The Football Manager is a co-opted position and as such, on a day to day basis they are accountable to the Secretary, Officers and other members of the Society Committee.

4. Working relationships

The Football Manager will work directly with the Secretary, Chairman and RA Delegates.
